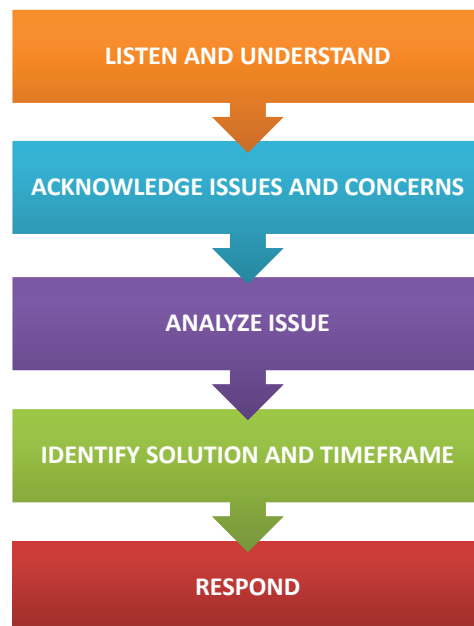

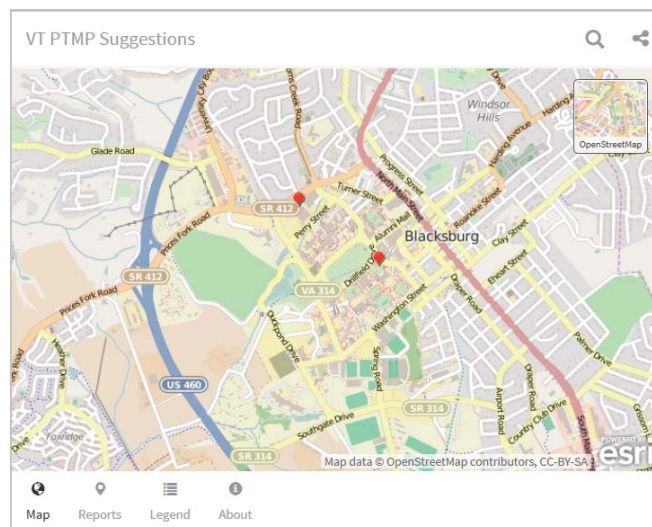

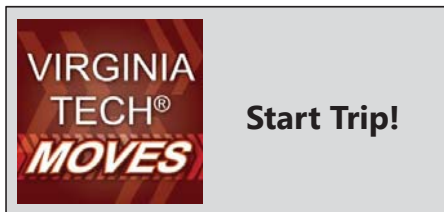
Interactive Suggestions Map
